TRAIN

Train leaves regularly from the Domestic Airport - one stop to Wolli Creek Station to take the South Coast Line to Kiama Station (a 2-hour journey and a 7- minute walk from the station to the Kiama Shores Motel).

CAR

1.5-2 hour-trip down the coast to Kiama via F6 Southern Freeway from Sydney CBD or Airport

Transfer from Airport to Kiama – A minibus has been organised to pick up members who fly into Sydney Airport on the Friday 15th October at 11.00 a.m. and at 2.30 p.m. An extra car will be organised if more transport is required.
