Hans Heyson

'Hans Heysen' is named after the famous South Australian artist. This pink rose has a very sweet fragrance, growing up to 1 metre tall with large blooms, repeating very well. I have grown it in a pot where it flowers profusely throughout the season.



Red Riding Hood

'Red Riding Hood' is a floribunda 'fairy-tale' bred by Kordes. This rose has small, neatly packed blooms in large clusters on arching branches. I

have it as a standard in the garden where it flowers well and is disease resistant.



Alfred Sisley

'Alfred Sisley' is one of the Delbard French painters series of roses. I have grown it in a pot and have found it to be an excellent, healthy specimen. It has incredibly glossy foliage and its flowers are speckled as if by a painter's brush. The blooms in red and orange shades glow in the sunlight and the fragrance is mild with an apple scent.
