- 3. PREVIOUS MINUTES: Accepted as correct. Moved Lorrie Zammit, Seconded Joanne Fisher
- 4. **FINANCIAL REPORT:** As sent out by Robert: Everyday Account \$3,219.23. Show Account \$7,001.58. Friends of Peace Park \$209.34. Fixed Deposit \$8,009.56. Moved by Robert Coady, Seconded Lorraine Vost.
- 5. A discussion on the upcoming rose show with volunteers needed for many tasks such as Rose Stripping to assist Joanne on Thursday, setting up on Friday morning, entrance and raffle tables to be manned at show as well as membership table. More people are needed to attend the Cocktail Party, Formal Dinner and Lectures at the Show, as well as the Farewell function, sale of roses and clearing up of the hall. The Photography Section is open to adults and children with good prizes.
