


# TO CO

#### **Summer Maintenance**

#### Summer

- Fertilise, top up mulch and deadhead
- Water well, especially pots
- Prune all once flowering ramblers such as Albertine, Banksia roses & heritage shubs i.e. Albas, Gallicas, Damasks
- Watch for spider mites in dry, hot weather
- Feed with organic fertiliser & water well
- Top up mulch
- Continue your spray program to maintain foliage and avoid sunburn
- If you are hybridising, this is the time to be pollenating roses
- Budding is best from mid to late summer
- (T) The third month of summer (early February in Australia) is the time for pruning for autumn rose shows and to help bring on a new flush of roses
