Roses must be included in all classes and must predominate. Other flowers are permitted in all classes. Any embellishments allowed in all classes. Space allowed is 60cm for each unit. Judging will be to the Standards of the Royal Horticultural Society of NSW Inc. The Judges decision is final.

Notes Supporting the Schedule

Cultivar: Where there is more than one stem or cut to a vase, they shall be of the same cultivar unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. All cultivars should be named.

Floral Foam can be used in all containers but must not extend past the top of the container. If used, it will be at exhibitor's own expense.

Stem: Original new growth which carries a single bloom or bud and has received no check from pinching, stopping or pruning from the time of starting into growth to flowering. Disbudding is not regarded as a check to growth under this definition. The stem should be proportionate in thickness and length to the size of the bloom it supports.

Cut: A cut is similar to a stem (original new growth) that carries one bloom and bud or buds or more than one bloom with or without side buds.

Exhibition Roses: These are roses registered as Hybrid Tea, Climbing Hybrid Tea, Large-Flowered Climber, Grandiflora or Climbing Grandiflora. Exhibition roses are shown singly. The presence of a bud or buds attached will disqualify. Wiring is permitted.

Bunch Roses: Roses are to be shown in single stems to the specified number per vase. Bunch Roses should have good length of stem and good foliage, blooms should be uniform in size, half open and at an even stage of development. Petals are to be more upright and not pelleted out as in Exhibition roses. Same cultivar, unless otherwise stated.

Decorative Roses: Roses registered as Hybrid Tea, Climbing Hybrid Tea, Large-Flowered Climber, Grandiflora or Climbing Grandiflora. Any number of buds or blooms per cut or stem is allowed. Blooms or buds may be at any stage of development. Vase of 4-6 cuts and/or stems, same cultivar, is to be marked with a sticker with "D" written on it. Single Hybrid Tea roses may be shown in this classification. A single rose has a single row of up to 5 petals and may have up to 3 additional petals in a second row.

Grandiflora Roses: These are roses registered as Grandiflora or Climbing Grandiflora. Vase of 1-6 cuts and/or stems, same cultivar, is to be marked with a sticker with "G" written on it.

Floribunda Roses: Roses registered as Floribunda, Climbing Floribunda, Grandiflora or Climbing Grandiflora. Vase of 1-6 cuts and/or stems, same cultivar, is to be marked with a sticker with "F" written on it.

Bloom: A bud is considered a bloom when one or more of the petals has started to unfurl.

Fully Open Bloom Rose: This is a rose that has reached full stage of opening, is fresh, pure in colour, circular in outline of good form and showing stamens. Stamens of the rose to be fresh. Side buds are not permitted. Evidence of the removal of petals/petalloids is a serious fault.

Bud to Fully Open Bloom: Bud to fully open bloom represents a rose of the same cultivar at four stages of its development and shall consist of four stems.

Distinct: To be of a different cultivar.

Same Cultivar: All stems are to be of the same rose cultivar.

N.N.D.: Not necessarily distinct, i.e. a combination of cultivars may be used.

Bowls: Bowls are provided by the Rose Society.

If you are unsure of the class applicable to any of your roses, please contact the Show Secretary who will assist. The most recent edition of Modern Roses will be used as the main reference in the resolution of any dispute or uncertainty.

Additional guidance is found in The National Rose Society of Australia Inc. (NRSA) Judges Handbook, Standards and Rules for Judging ROSES V3, 2024; the two sets of Guidelines, Appendix 'E' - Show Regulations and Appendix 'F' - Show Schedule, available on the The Rose Society of NSW Inc. website, members section.
