NOTES SUPPORTING THE SCHEDULE

Bloom: A bud is considered a bloom when one or more of the petals has started to unfurl.

Bowls: Bowls are provided by the Rose Society.

Bud to Fully Open Bloom: Bud to fully open bloom represents a rose of the same cultivar at four stages of its development and shall consist of four stems.

Bunch Roses: Roses are to be shown in single stems to the specified number per vase. Bunch Roses should have good length of stem and good foliage, blooms should be uniform in size, half open and at an even stage of development. Petals are to be more upright and not pelleted out as in Exhibition roses. Same cultivar, unless otherwise stated.

Cultivar: Where there is more than one stem or cut to a vase, they shall be of the same cultivar unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. All cultivars should be named.

Cut: A cut is similar to a stem (original new growth) that carries one bloom and bud or buds or more than one bloom with or without side buds.

Decorative Roses: Any number of buds or blooms per cut or stem is allowed. Blooms or buds may be at any stage of development. Vase of 4-6 cuts and/or stems, same cultivar, minimum 10 blooms is marked with a sticker with 'D' written on it . Single hybrid tea roses may be shown in this classification. A single rose has a single row of 5 petals but may have up to 3 additional petals in a second row.

Distinct: To be of a different cultivar.

Exhibition Roses: These are roses registered as Hybrid Tea. Exhibition roses are shown singly, one bloom to a vase. The presence of a bud or buds attached will disqualify. Wiring is permitted.

Floral Foam can be used in all containers but must not extend past the top of the container. If used, it will be at exhibitor's own expense.

Floribunda Roses: In this schedule roses registered and classified as Floribunda Roses, must only be shown in Floribunda Classes.

Fully Open Bloom Rose: This is a rose that has reached full stage of opening, is fresh, pure in colour, circular in outline of good form and showing stamens. Stamens of the rose to be fresh. Side buds are not permitted. The removal of petaloids is not permitted.

Grandiflora Roses: These are roses registered as Grandiflora or Climbing Grandiflora. Vase of 1-6 cuts and/or stems, same cultivar, unlimited blooms is to be marked with a sticker with 'G' written on it. Roses classified as Grandiflora Roses may not be staged in classes that specify Floribunda Roses.

N.N.D.: Not necessarily distinct, i.e. a combination of cultivars may be used.

Same Cultivar: All stems are to be of the same rose cultivar.

Stem: Original new growth which carries a single bloom or bud and has received no check from pinching, stopping or pruning from the time of starting into growth to flowering. Disbudding is not regarded as a check to growth under this definition. The stem should be proportionate in thickness and length to the size of the bloom it supports.

NOTE: If you are unsure of the class applicable to any of your roses, please contact the Show Secretary who will assist. The most recent edition of Modern Roses will be used as the main reference in the resolution of any dispute or uncertainty.
